

FLIPPED CLASS ROOM – AN IMPORTANT PRE-LEARNING TECHNIQUE

- ❖ Flipped class room can be considered as a special kind of Active Learning in which students can participate actively in the area.
- ❖ In regular class room the instructors give lectures first, then home work
- ❖ In Flipped class room first lecturing from the home (basic understanding of the concept) using video lectures, materials from internet etc and homework at school.

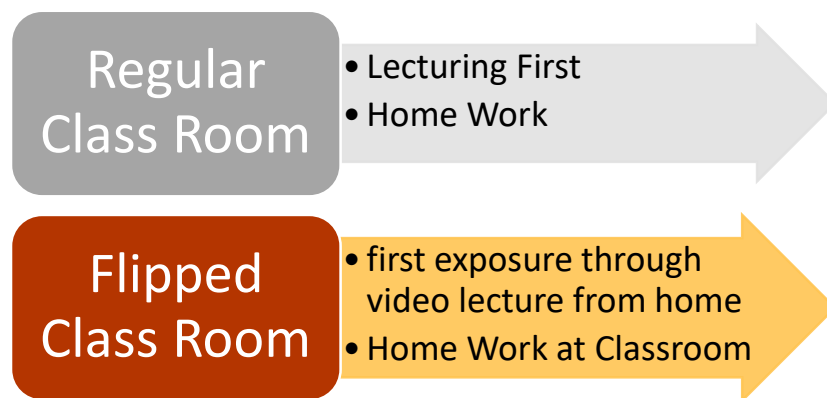


Fig: Lecturing Methods – A comparison

Advantage of Flipped Class Room

- Lower Level BT (Remember & Understanding) can be achieved from home by reading materials or watching Video Lectures.
- Higher Level BT (Apply, Analyze, Evaluate and Create) can be achieved from class room with the help of the instructor.

Class room can be used for discussions, peer interactions (sharing) for improving the thinking capability of students.

Based on that discussions, instructors can provide multiple choice questions to assess the understanding levels of students

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
